

**CARROLL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY
RESOLUTION NO. 3 OF 1999**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CARROLL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY,
WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE
DISCONNECTION AND TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICES
TO REALTY AND STRUCTURES FOR FAILURE TO PAY SEWER
RENTAL FEES.**

WHEREAS, the Carroll Township Authority (the "Authority") provides sewage collection and treatment services to residents with the Township of Carroll, County of Washington, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Authority imposes a sanitary sewage fee to cover the cost of collection and treatment of sanitary sewage; and

WHEREAS, the failure of customers to promptly paid said fees is detrimental to the economic stability of the Authority and is unfair to the majority of residents who pay timely their sewage treatment fees; and

WHEREAS, the loss of revenue due to failure to timely pay the sanitary sewer renter fees is not in the best interest of the welfare and safety of the citizens within the service area of the Authority; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT REOLVED AND IT IS HERBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Carroll Township Authority shall from time to time, send a notice for the demand of payment in the amount of the delinquent monies owed for the use of the sanitary sewers including delinquent charges owed to the Carroll Township Authority to the owners of record of the premises where such sewage originates.
2. Said notice or demand of payment shall state the total amount of money owed, together with the notice for said delinquent account may be paid. Said demand for payment shall contain a notice that if said amount is not paid within a period of thirty days from the date of the notice, then the Authority, in addition to any other legal remedies it may have, shall notify the appropriate water company to disconnect and terminate all water service to the realty where there are outstanding delinquent sewage charges.
3. In addition to the charges for the use of sanitary sewers, the Authority shall add a charge to cover the costs of the notice in the amount of \$20.00 to advertise said cost including postage in addition to any other costs incurred.
4. The notice or demand for payment may be amended by the Authority Board by motion at any time.
