

RESOLUTION NO. 5 OF 1999

RESOLUTION OF THE CARROLL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY ADOPTING FEES FOR DISHONORED CHECKS, INTEREST RATES FOR DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS AND MUNICIPAL CLAIMS, PENALTIES, CHARGES FOR POSTING OF WATER SHUT-OFF AND WATER TURN-ON, TAP-IN FEES, NO LIEN CERTIFICATES, AND INSPECTION AND RE-INSPECTION FEES.

WHEREAS, the Carroll Township Authority has from time to time adopted various fees, penalties, and interest rates in regard to the collection of sewage charges for the collection and treatment of sewage generated in Carroll Township, no lien certificates and tap-in fees and inspections.

WHEREAS, the Carroll Township Authority is desirous of amending and codifying the charges, penalties, and interest charges.

NOW THEREFORE, the Carroll Township Authority approves the following:

1. Schedule of fees, penalties, and interest rates charges as set forth below
  - (a) Dishonored Checks. Any check not honored and paid by customers financial institution. \$25.00
  - (b) Delinquent Account Penalty. A charge to any customer for bills not paid on or before the due date. 10% or 0.833% per month
  - (c) Municipal Claims. Interest charge on balance owed as of date of filing. 10%
  - (d) Water Shut-Off. Posting charge and certified letter \$20.00
  - (e) Water Turn-on. Charge to reactivate service after shut-off \$10.00
  - (f) No Lien Certificate. Issued upon request to customers usually where real estate is being sold \$25.00  
Downspout Inspection \$30.00

(g) <u>Tap In Fee.</u>	Residential homes 1 EDU	\$2,400.00
	Commercial Establishment or Multi-dwelling	\$2,400.00 per EDU
(h) <u>Re-inspection fee.</u>	Service line failed initial inspection	\$35.00

2. This resolution shall take effect on January 1, 2000

3. If any sentence, clause or section or any part of the Resolution is found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of the Resolution.

4. Any Resolutions or parts of Resolutions which are contrary to or conflict with the provisions of the Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Resolution full force and effect.
